- The Bellaire Belles are the dance team for Bellaire High School in Bellaire Texas
- The Belles perform at half time of every Cardinal football game, some basketball games, and cheer on the Cardinal volleyball team at some games.
- Honor Corps is the “team within the team” – the elite dance team for the Belles consisting of sophomores, juniors and seniors who audition for a place on the team.
